1. The meeting commenced with a brief on the progress of preparations of MUREE courses. PSUT will send partners the course description forms for them to fill and return them by Tuesday 25 March 2014 at the latest. The description of each course should include title, objectives, and content.
2. Partners agreed that PSUT sends letters to presidents of Jordanian partner universities requesting to accredit and integrate the 6 MUREE courses into the existing study plans in the renewable energy field in their universities.

The partners agreed to include students in these visits, 1-2 from each partner university. Dr. Abdallah Al Zoubi stressed on the importance of gender balance when selecting the nominees.

He suggested that each workpackage coordinator fill in the information on their work packages, and the obstacles they face during the timeline of the project.
